The Alberta Junior Athletic Award recognizes and rewards the athletic excellence of junior sport athletes and provides an incentive for these athletes to continue with their post-secondary education. This award is sponsored by the Alberta Heritage Scholarship Fund, Alberta Junior Football teams, the Friends of Alberta Junior Hockey Society and the Prairie Baseball Academy.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicant must:

- be a Canadian citizen, Permanent Resident or Protected Person (visa students are not eligible),
- be an Alberta resident, and to be considered an Alberta resident one of the following conditions must apply:
 - one parent, or legal guardian has maintained permanent residence in Canada for at least twelve (12) consecutive months immediately prior to commencing post-secondary studies and be residing in Alberta, or
 - Alberta is the last place the student has lived for twelve (12) consecutive months immediately prior to commencing post-secondary studies, or
 - the student's spouse/partner has maintained permanent residence in Alberta for 12 consecutive months prior to the person attending post-secondary
- be a participant in a designated sports team (Prairie Baseball Academy, Alberta Junior Hockey or Football team),
- be currently enrolled as a full-time student at a post-secondary institution in Alberta, and
- have achieved a grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale in the previous term of study.

Students in upgrading or college preparation programs may be eligible after completing one term of upgrading provided they meet the athletic requirements.

Apprenticeship students may be eligible after completing one term of an apprenticeship program.

Selection Process

Team Coaches of the designated sports team in Alberta nominate athletes based on academic standing, community involvement and athletic achievements. Nominations are forwarded to Alberta Student Aid for final approval and payment.

Application Process

Applicant must include:

- a current official transcript, and
- an attachment outlining the applicant's extracurricular activities and future goals (essay).

Additional Information

The award will be issued in March after Alberta Student Aid confirms full-time enrolment in a post-secondary institution.

- There are thirty (30) awards available to Alberta Junior Football teams.
- There are ten (10) awards available to Friends of Alberta Junior Hockey Society.
- There are thirty (30) awards available to Prairie Baseball Academy.
